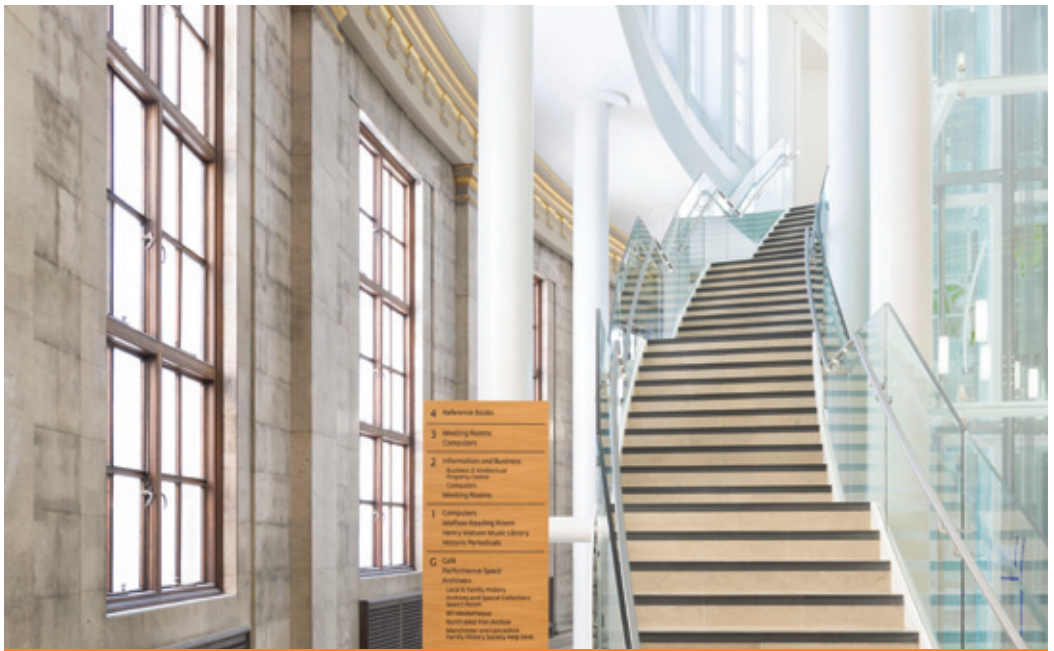

We are also passionate about supporting the outreach work of Central Library, and Trust funds are used to help develop engagement programmes and events for all sections of the community.





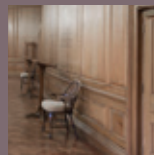
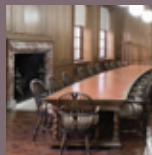
BECOME PART OF THE STORY
